
## Instructions for Assembling HAWK'S All Plastic Airplane Kit of

## DART XF-92A



Catalog No. 605 - DART XF-92A (1/72" scale)

Study sketch of DART carefully and read these instructions thoroughly before assembling.

Place all parts of plane on work-table as shown in sketch. Remove any rough edges with a knife, fine file or sandpaper. Use polystyrene cement for gluing. Be very careful in assembling not to get cement on outer surfaces of plane parts.

## **ASSEMBLY**

- 1. Cement both parts of stand together and set aside to dry.
- 2. Apply cement around edge of one half of fuselage. Press the two halves of fuselage together and hold until cement sets.
- 3. Apply cement to edge of "greenhouse" and place firmly over cockpit.
- 4. Apply cement to wing stubs and insert in fuselage holes.
- 5. Cement nose spear into air separator (see sketch), then cement edges of separator and slip into nose opening (stops on the inside of

- fuselage determine the correct depth to insert spear and separator).
- 6. Cement radio mast in place (see sketch).
- 7. Cement bottom of streamlined control housing and place on indicated positions under wings.
- 8. Cement completed model to stand and let dry thoroughly.
- Read instructions on back of decals before applying. See sketch for correct positions of decals.
- 10. Plane is molded in the proper base color, but if you should decide to paint plane use a good grade of enamel (NOT LACQUER).
