

# **RAFTyphoon Squadrons** 1:48 **Euro Decols** 3(F) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Coningsby. Modellers Note: 3(F) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s only. Modellers Note: 3(F) Squadron carried/carries the White fin aircraft designation letters starting with 'QO', i.e. 'QO-H'. 6(F) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Lossiemouth. Modellers Note: 6(F) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s and T.3s. Modellers Note: 6(F) Squadron carried/carries two digit White aircraft designation letters starting with 'E', i.e. 'EM' for NATO Air Policing over the Baltic in 2020 it carried the '70 Years Of NATO' badge on the fin with a three digit White number starting with '3' i.e. 333.

## RAFTyphoon Squadrons 1:48 Euro Decale IX(F) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Lossiemouth. **Modellers Note:** IX Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s only. WS-J Modellers Note: IX Squadron carried/carries the last three numbers of the airframe serial on the fin. WS-Modellers Note: IX Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s. **Modellers Note:** A small number of IX Squadron Typhoons carried/carry Cherry Red 'WS-\_' codes on the fin. Noted examples were 'WS-C', 'WS-G', 'WS-J', 'WS-L', 'WS-R', 'WS-T', 'WS-U', 'WS-W' & 'WS-Y' Modellers Note: ZJ914 was the sole 'Aggressor' airframe and was thus painted in an overall Black scheme. It was originally rolled out with just last three numbers of the airframe serial on the fin but later had the Cherry Red 'WS-T' aircraft code letters applied too. Cherry Red and Roundel Blue national insignia were also applied.

Modellers Note: XI(F) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s only. **Modellers Note:** XI(F) Squadron carried/carries a White two letter code on the fin starting with 'D\_', i.e. 'DA' but airframes were also seen with just the last three numbers of the airframe serial in White on the fin. The original rollout of ZJ914 saw the Squadron bars Black & Yellow areas reversed in error. 12(B) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Coningsby. Modellers Note: 12(B) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s and T.3s. Modellers Note: 12(B) Squadron carries the last three digits of the serial number in White on the fin.



# **RAFTyphoon Squadrons** 1:48 Euro Decals 41(R) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Coningsby. Modellers Note: 41(R) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s and T.3s. Modellers Note: 41(R) Squadron carried a White three letter code on the fin starting with 'EB-\_', i.e. 'EB-J' but airframes were also seen with just the last three numbers of the airframe serial in White and also a two letter code starting with either 'D\_' i.e. 'DS' or 'E\_' as in 'EV'.
