





MBB 105 CB-3 &CBS HKP 9A & B





09414, HKP 9B, F94 - F6 Karlsborg. Pressure bottles for the inflatable floats were located on the right lower side of the fuselage. Stencils according to 09009 and 09010. Initially this a/c also had the earlier SAR badge just like 09415.



09415, HKP 9B, G93 - F7 Såtenäs. Four HKP 9B were used by the Swedish Alr Force at F6, F7 and F13 between 1985 and 1994 and replaced the older Alouette II, HKP 2. The airframe was painted in Dark Green 326, same as the bottom colour on HKP 9A (and Viggen for example) but due to a gloss finnish it looked slightly darker. Stencils according to 09009 and 09010.
