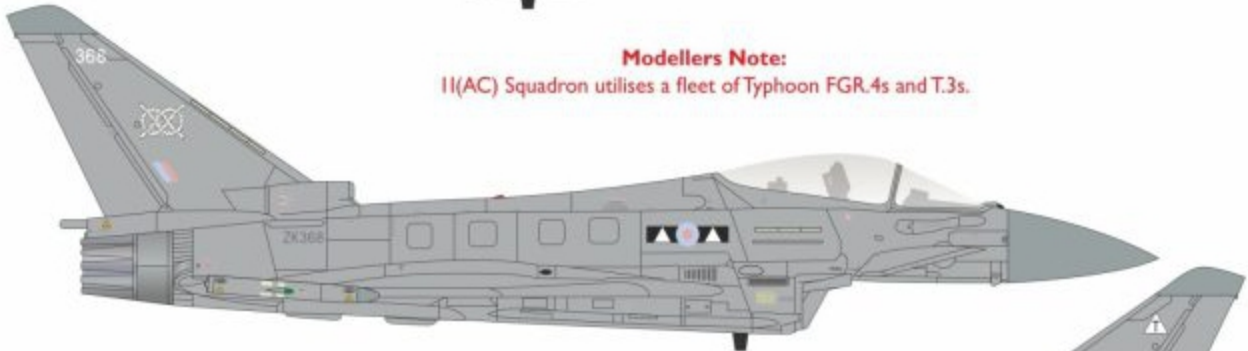
II(AC) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Lossiemouth.

Modellers Note:

ZJ914 was the sole 'Aggressor' airframe and was thus painted in an overall Black scheme. It was originally rolled out with just last three numbers of the airframe serial on the fin but later had the Cherry Red 'WS-T' aircraft code letters applied too. Cherry Red and Roundel Blue national insignia were also applied.

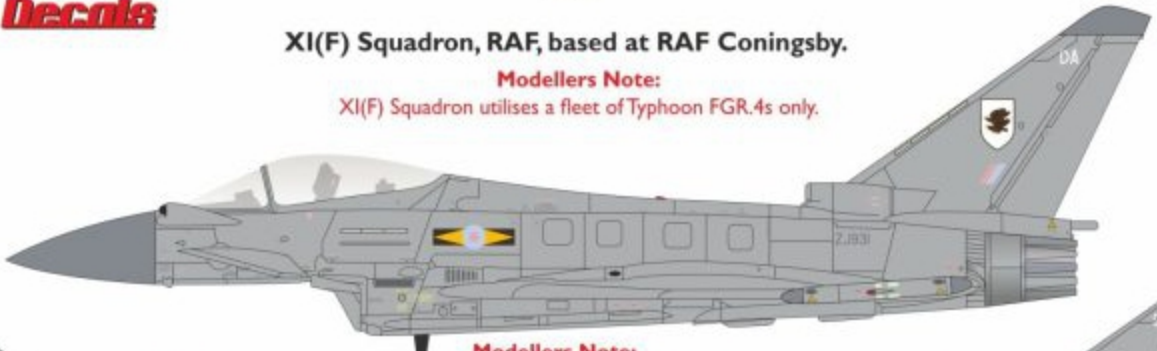

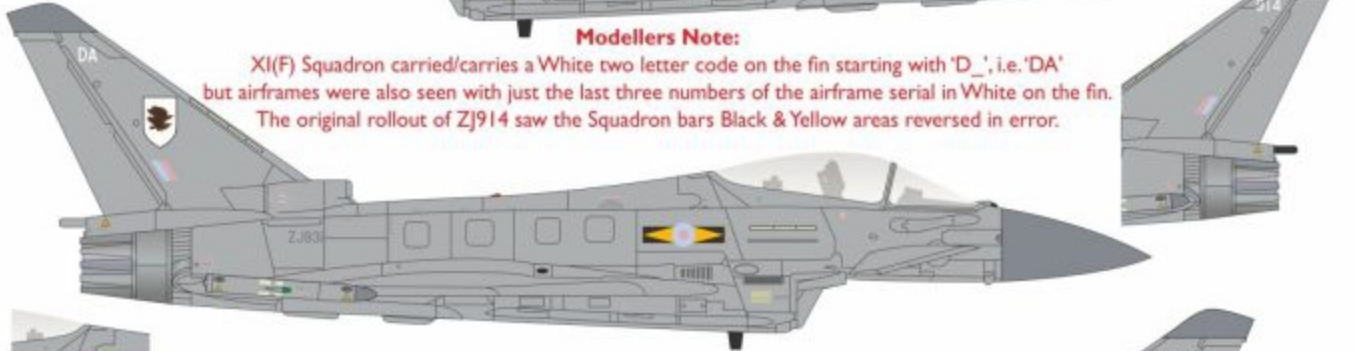
XI(F) Squadron utilises a fleet of Typhoon FGR.4s only.

XI(F) Squadron carried/carries a White two letter code on the fin starting with 'D_', i.e. 'DA' but airframes were also seen with just the last three numbers of the airframe serial in White on the fin. The original rollout of ZJ914 saw the Squadron bars Black & Yellow areas reversed in error.



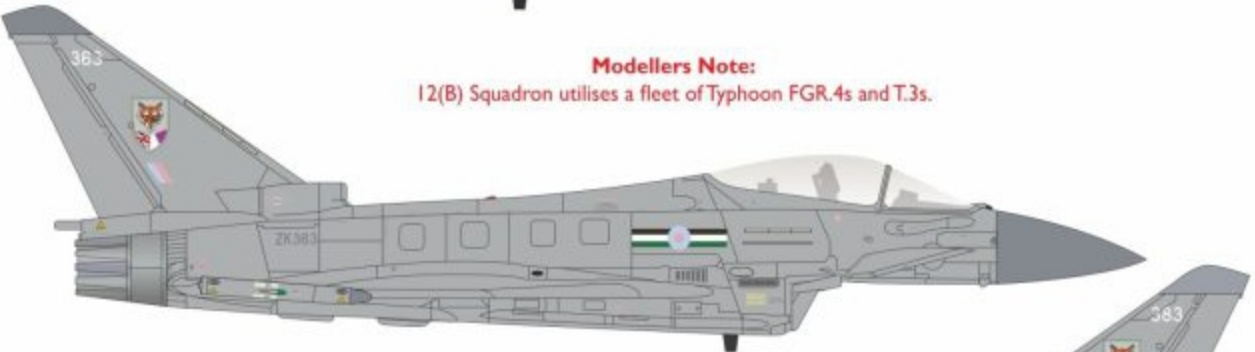
I2(B) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Coningsby.

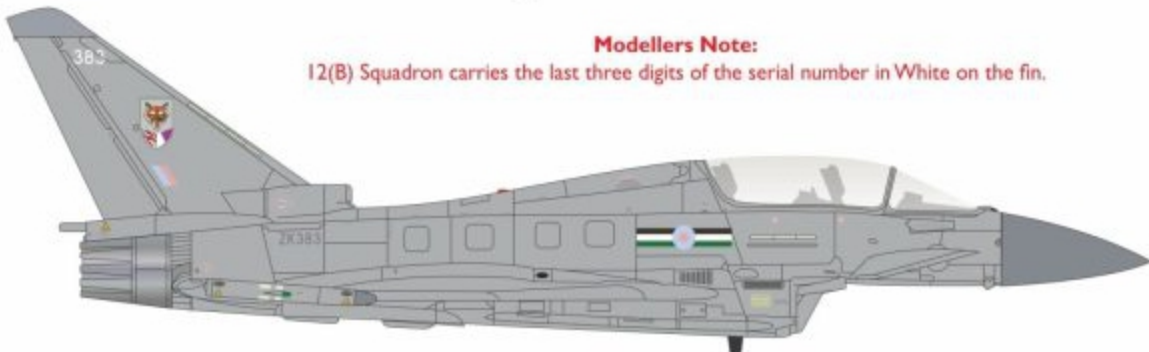

I2(B) Squadron carries the last three digits of the serial number in White on the fin.



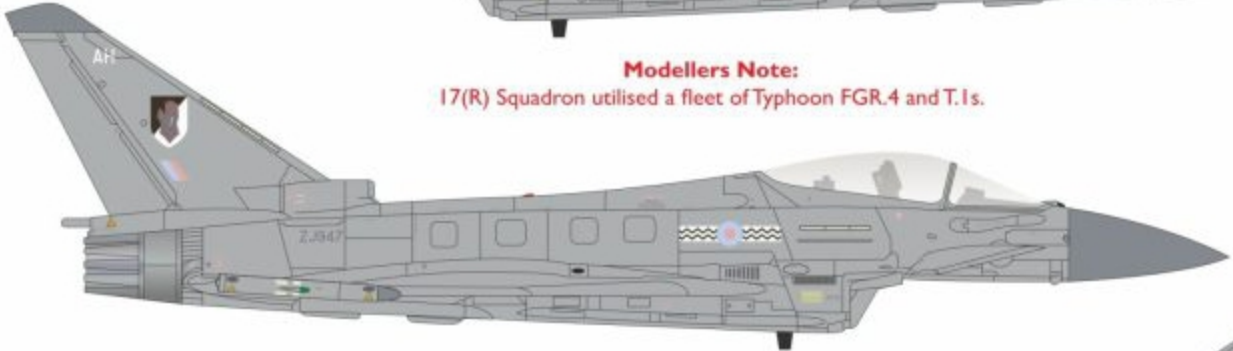
17(R) Squadron, RAF, based at RAF Coningsby.
