



MIRAGE-2000

The Mirage 2000 attack fighter is a multi-role aircraft designed to provide air defense, deep strike, nuclear deterrence, reconnaissance and close air support. With a fly-by-wire flight control system, the aircraft is able to attain superb speed and demonstrates excellent operating efficiency in flight. It was deployed in 1983 by the French Air Force and has various subtypes including the 2000B, 2000N & 2000D versions.

Unlike other aircraft in the world, the Mirage family is not named by the alphabet series. Mirage 2000 B, with B for "biplace", is the fifth prototypes of mirage 2000. It is the two-seat trainer model of Mirage 2000 with the fuselage lengthened to 14.55M for the second cockpit. While Mirage 2000B is able to carry 6300 kg (13889 lb) of disposable stores, it is a highly agile aircraft which achieved supersonic speed of approximately Mach 1.4 during its first flight on 11 October 1980.

The Mirage 2000N (N=nucléaire), a member of the French Nuclear Forces, was designed to carry the Aerospatiale Air-Sol Moyenne Portee (ASMP) nuclear stand-off missile which has a maximum range of 100 km. Compared to the Mirage 2000 fighter model, the 2000N has a strengthened airframe and performs better at low-altitude flight. It can also carry two Magic AAMs for self-defense. While the export versions of the Mirage 2000 are popular among countries such as Egypt, Greece, India, Taiwan and United Arab Emirates, the 2000N version is not licensed for export due to its nuclear capability.

Modifications to the Mirage 2000N have resulted in the Mirage 2000D (D=diversifie), which is the 2000N's conventional attack counterpart. It is basically the same as the Mirage 2000N with additional optimizations for long-range precision strikes and conventional bombing missions, and is able to carry a wide range of French air-to-surface weaponry. In 2008, the French Air Force deployed three Mirage 2000D aircraft to Kandahar in Afghanistan to provide support for the Nato International Security Assistance Force (ISAF).
